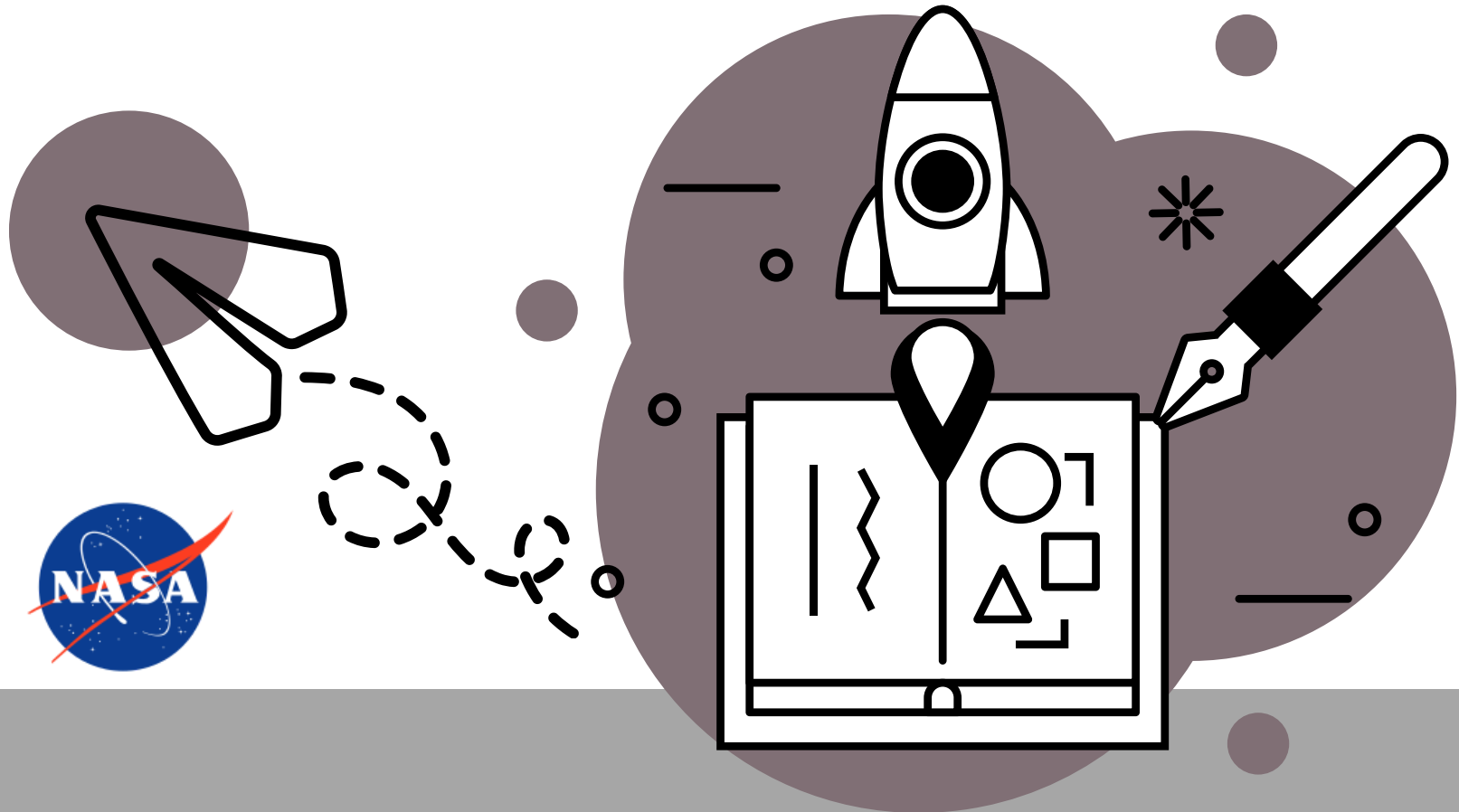

K-12 TEACHER STEM GRANT



ELIGIBILITY

Proposals are welcome from K-12 teachers from all Ohio school districts.

AWARD

- Maximum amount of award per teacher or project is \$1,000
- Receiving school/institution must provide 100% matching funds which can be cash and or “in kind” contributions (i.e., cost of applicant’s time, transportation costs, equipment supplied by other sources, volunteers’ time, etc.)
- Notification of application status within 1 month of receiving application

FUNDED PROGRAMS

- Promote STEM education
- Have long reaching impact
- Can be replicated by other schools/institutions
- Involve inter-disciplinary initiatives
- Include parental involvement

APPLICATION

- Accepted throughout the year
- Available for download at <http://www.osgc.org/Minigrant.html>
- Brief description of project
- Procedures
- Impact and benefits to school/institution
- Detailed budget including matching funds
- Curriculum Vitae of applicant

GUIDELINES

- Funds may be used to purchase materials or supplies and/or support field trips that are an integral part of a project. There must be pre- and post-trip activities and the site visit must have a structured STEM program.
- Funds may not be used for non-STEM related equipment, computers, tuition, or to compensate school personnel.
- A complete budget is required with the application that lists OSGC funds as well as matching funds.
- Acknowledgement of OSGC funding must be included on all advertising and marketing of programs.
- Final reports on the project are due no later than one year after award date.
